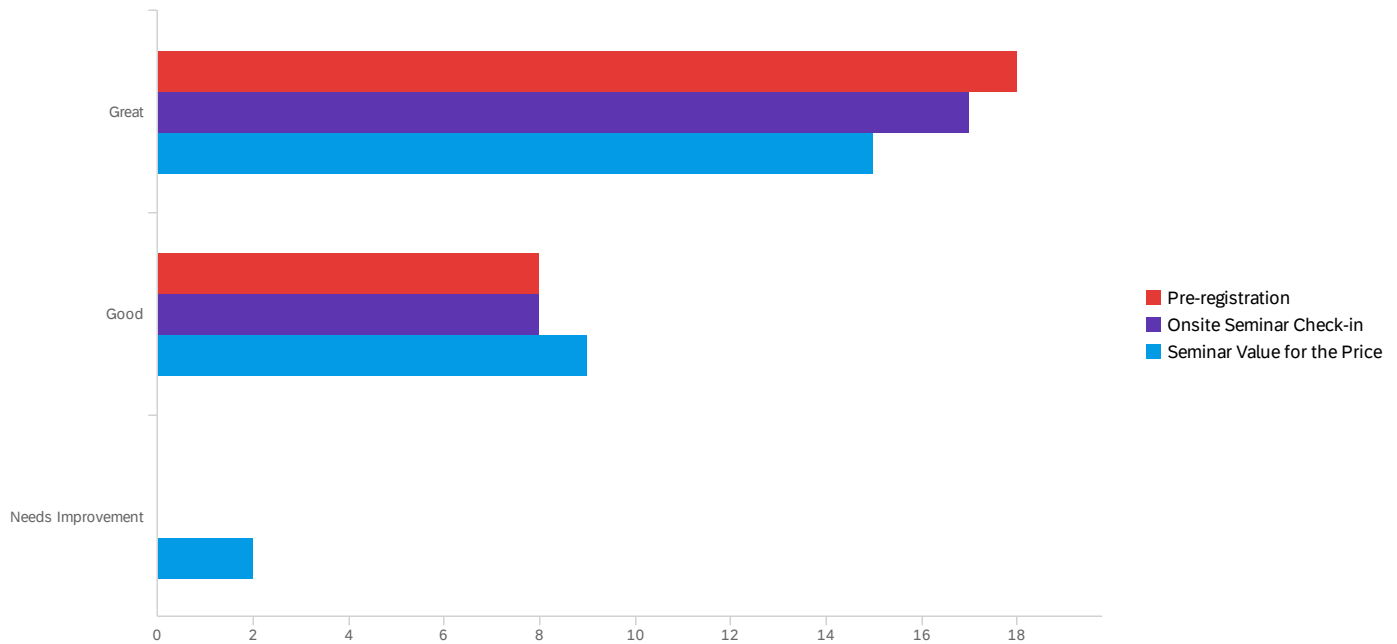

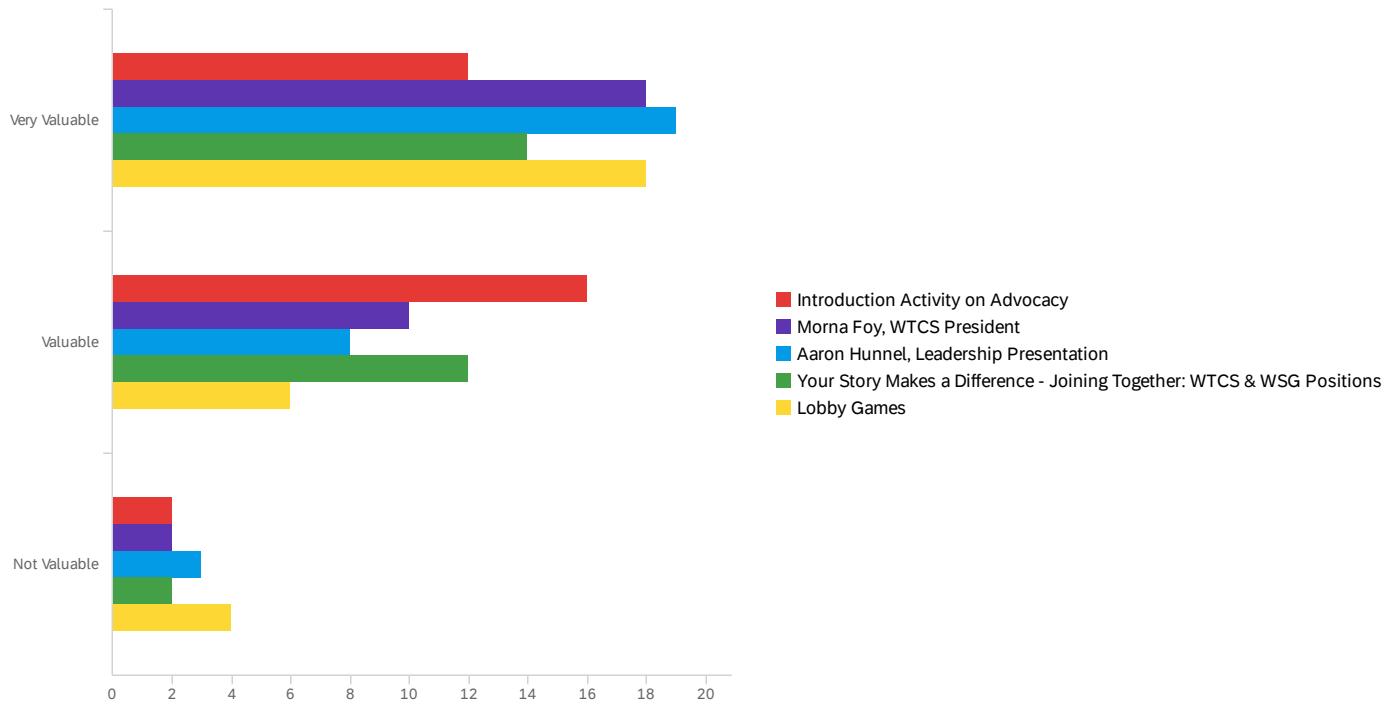

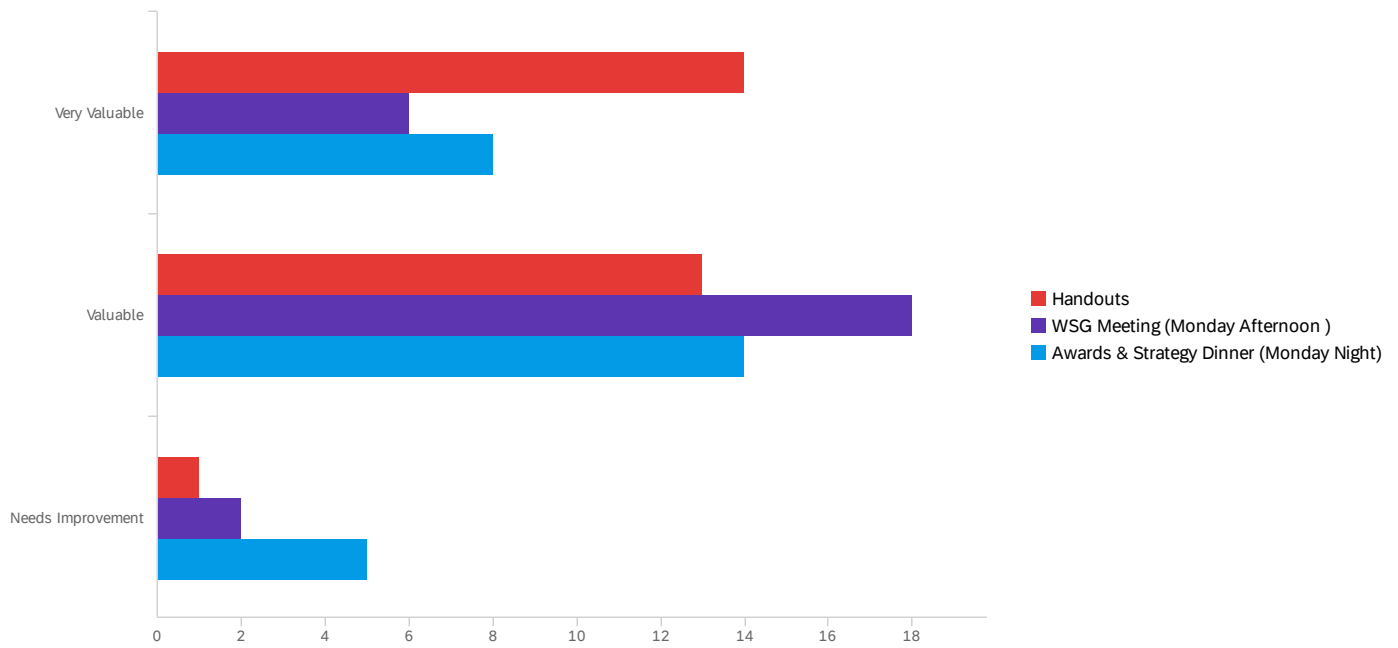
The speaker was kind of flat and uninspired

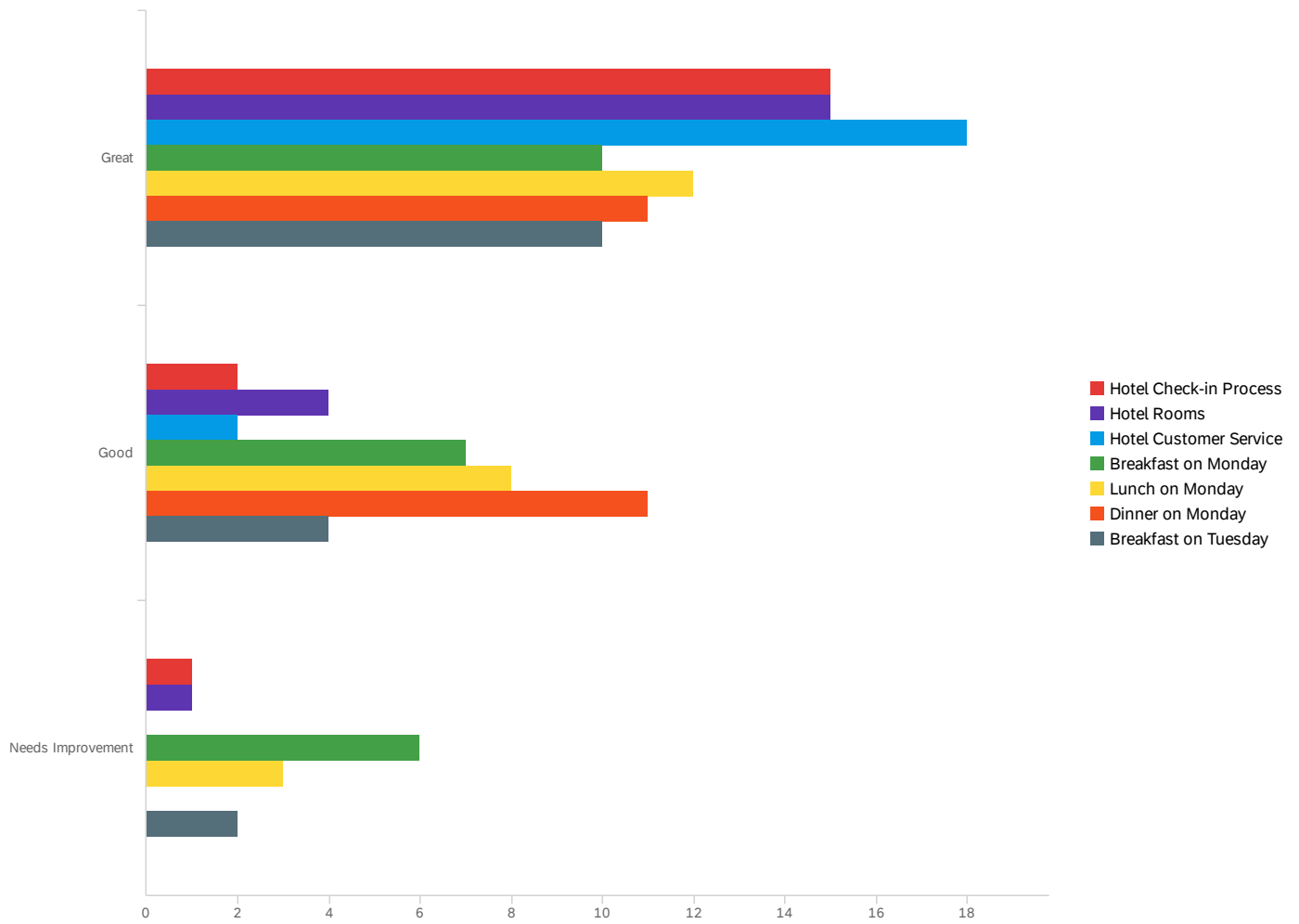
